### Tools:

Basic layout tools,  
Block plane  
Bench chisels  
Drafting type compass, with divider points

### Carving tools:

I suggest you purchase these in advance so that you can finish any final honing that they may need. The number to the right of each tool listed is the stock number for the "Swissmade" brand available from Woodcraft – 10% student discount applies if you purchase from the Manchester Woodcraft store.

#5 sweep 20 mm.	05D07
#5 sweep fishtail 8 mm.	05M07
#1 sweep skew chisel double bevel 8 mm.	05A10
#11 sweep veiner 10 mm.	05I10
#25 sweep back bent 10 mm.	05J09
#12 sweep V-parting tool 6 mm.	05J06
#1sweep straight chisel single bevel 20 mm.	05V02 a sharp bench chisel can be substituted

I strongly suggest acquiring your own carving tools for this class (they are common sizes and sweeps that you will use in other projects, however; the school will have two sets of these tools available to share if you prefer.
